Product # 1: The Photo-Panels

Photo-Panels are photographic images printed directly onto stone-like tablets and framed using reclaimed timber that would otherwise end up in landfill. **Environmentally friendly**, durable, non-reflective, glass-less images that are lightweight, **stylish** and **affordable**.



NB the frame 'finish' can vary from a raw, unstained finish (as above on the sides) to a warmer smooth stain such as Black Japan.

Standard sizes include 13 cm wide x 13 cm high x 1.5 inches deep and 30 cm wide x 30 cm high x 1.5 inches deep. Rectangular format is also available up to A3 in size.

Photo-Panel Environmental Statement:

The aim of the Photo-Panel is to be a carbon neutral product, working towards being a carbon credit. The Photo-Panel is made from: Timber, Liquid Stone and EPS.

The timber is acquired from industry and salvaged from renovation and demolition. This timber is often in thin lengths and no longer a viable building product and discarded (at cost) to landfill.

Polystyrene (EPS) forms the backing for the Photo-Panel, creating structure and support so the panel can remain lightweight. EPS is extremely hard to recycle and largely ends up in landfill. What is recycled uses vast amounts of energy for little outcome and ends up in road fill. Photo-Panel reuses EPS directly from manufacturing waste such as fruit boxes from the Queen Victoria Market and refrigeration/electrical goods packaging.

Liquid stone is a composite of gypsum based cement and industrial by-products to create a unique porcelain-like surface.

Pricing:

I currently sell the 13 x 13 cm size for \$145 and the 30 x 30 cm size for \$295. Prices for other sizes are available on application.

Product # 2: Redheads Matchbox Miniatures

The 'Matchbox Miniatures' are a **set of 10 hand-cut miniature photos** housed inside an iconic Redheads matchbox (53 mm w x 36 mm h x 15 mm deep). They are served on a bed of hand-torn paper and each set contains a different series of images. (Obviously the matches have been removed so there is no flambé potential. 😊) Currently images depict the tension and interaction between the human and natural worlds but I intend to create a number of new series on a variety of themes.

They are **ultra affordable** and great as a simple gift or keepsake for those on a budget or simply for lovers of icons and cute miniatures.

In addition to the traditional Redheads box they are also available for a limited time in **limited edition boxes** featuring the iconic Redhead woman together with other Icons of Oz on the box - The Big Koala, The Big Galah, The Big Merino, The Big Penguin and more. I am also considering creating a new size suitable for the larger Redheads boxes.



Pricing:

The traditional iconic box design, pictured above, is \$10 per box. The limited edition versions, as per previous page, are \$ 15 per box.

Me:

I'm a photo-artist based at The Abbotsford Convent Arts Precinct in Melbourne, Australia. I focus on the tension and interaction between the human and natural worlds, one's sense of place and belonging in these worlds, and our common human bond. The mundane, overlooked and in-between bits of life are what interest me the most.
